12.1 LODGING A PROTEST OR APPEAL

All protests and / or appeals must be lodged in accordance with the stipulations of Articles 13,14 and 15 of the Code.

12.2 **PROTEST FEES**

- All parties concerned shall be given adequate notice of the hearing of any appeal. They shall be entitled to call witnesses, but their failure to attend the hearing shall not interrupt the course of the proceedings.
- The confirmation of an appeal to the FMSCI must be accompanied by a fee of ₹113,280/= (Rupees One Lakh Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Only).
- This fee becomes due from the moment the appellant notifies the Steward of the intention of appealing, and remains payable even if the appellant does not follow up the declared intention to appeal.
- If the appeal is rejected or it is withdrawn after being brought, no part of the fee shall be returned.
- If judged partially founded, the fee may be returned in part, and in its entirety if the appeal is upheld.
- If it is proved that the author of the appeal has acted in bad faith, the FMSCI may inflict upon them one of the penalties laid down in the Code.

The competitors briefing will be held at a time and venue noted under point 8 above. All competitors MUST attend the briefing where an attendance register will be maintained. Non attendance will be reported to the stewards and shall entail a penalty of Rs2000/ and or disqualification.

Any vehicle taking part in the event must be pr presented by the competitor or his official representative to scrutineering at a time and venue noted under point 8 above. Competitors not adhering to the schedule will be charged a late scrutiny fee of Rs100/minute for a maximum of 15 minutes after which the competitor will be excluded. There will no refund of entry fees.

The FMSCI Technical delegate or Steward can at their discretion can dismantle and scrutinise any vehicle at any given time during the course of the event.

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ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS BY THE ORGANISER

- 1. Late fee entries shall be 50% additional of the normal fee.
- 2. Minimum 4 entiries to form a class, if insufficient entires are received for a class, the class maybe cancelled or maybe merged with the next higher class.


